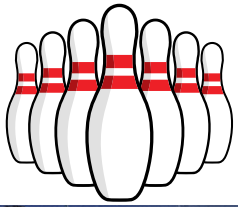

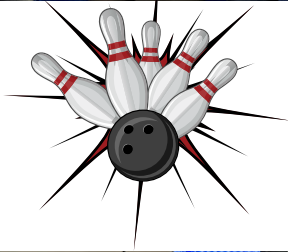

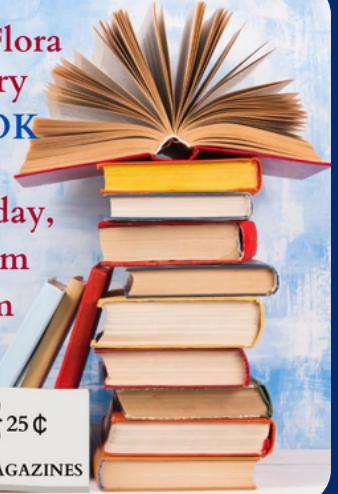

Q: Have the qualifications for a discount changed?

A: No, general qualifications have not changed. Riders will need to obtain and show ID Card.

Q: When can I expect to receive my Reduced Fare ID card?

A: Cards will be sent with-in 7-10 business days after approval.

Q: What does suggested donation fare mean?

A: Riders donate to the system at their discretion and ability to do so.
