Cruz underwent an appendectomy. After surgery, Cruz still did not improve. It was then discovered that Cruz had two large abscesses around his liver. After a blood transfusion. Cruz was able to receive further treatment. Due to the severity of his infection Cruz remained in the hospital for 3 weeks on IV medication. Cruz's parents are both selfemployed and had to take time off to care for Cruz.
