5th Annual Amateur Doubles Disc Golf Tournament The Flora Chamber of Commerce is excited to host their 5th Annual Amateur Doubles Disc Golf Tournament at the Flora Rotary Disc Golf Course in Charley Brown Memorial Park in Flora, IL. We would like to thank all the local businesses who are sponsoring the event as well as the Flora Rotary Club and the City of Flora for making a very nice course.

Registration Information: This will be a trophy only event with winners for all three divisions getting a 3d printed trophy. The players pack and other free event activities will be worth at least the cost of registration. Each registered player will receive a players pack. The disc will be from the Chuckin' Aces DGC stock and will be your choice between 5 different molds and 3 different stamps. The Chamber stamped drawstring bag will only be available to players who register more than 2 weeks in advance since we will need time to order and have them shipped.

Temp hole 6B (down the sledding hill) will be a separate \$50 CTP sponsored by Flora Bank & Trust. All baskets will be located at the short pin position so there should be 8 - 14 ace opportunities depending on your throwing distance. Ace on temp hole 6B and win both pots! If no aces are hit then a 50/50 CTP contest will be held after winners are announced.

Choose your division for registration using the following standards for the BEST PLAYER on your team. There must be at least 3 teams in any division to qualify for a trophy. Registrations will be on the honor system and will not be checked:

NOVICE - PDGA rating of under 850 with at least 1 rated round in the last year or no PDGA number having played disc golf regularly for less than 2 years. The NOVICE group will play the White tee pads.
 ADVANCED - PDGA rating of 850 or greater with at least 1 rated round in the last year or no PDGA number having played disc golf regularly for more than 2 years. The ADVANCED group will play the Blue tee pads.
 MIXED - The mixed division must consist of two players of different genders. There are no PDGA rating or disc golf experience limits. The MIXED group will play a mixture of White and Blue.

Tournament Info:

42 holes played - 2 rounds of 21 - - Standard scramble "best disc" rules.

Discs surrounded by water, on or across roads, and on top of buildings will be OB. Exact rules will be available in the caddy guide that will be emailed the week of the event.

Extra Items On-Site:

Food will be available on-site and an optional meal (pork burger, chips, and drink) will be provided free with player registration. Non-players can have the same lunch for just \$5. Online registrants can choose whether or not they would like the meal.

FREE Disc Golf Clinic will be held after lunch for anyone interested in learning about the sport. The basics of throwing and putting will be covered. Practice baskets and discs will be available to use.






Come to the historic Flora Depot in Flora, to purchase your ticket and take a hayride through Elmwood Cemetery to see skits about local Flora residents and the events in their lives. On January 1, 2024, the Corporate Transparency Act went into effect requiring many small businesses to file a Beneficial Ownership Information (BOI) report with FinCEN.





What is BOI or Beneficial Ownership Information?

A beneficial owner is the individuals who ultimately own or control a business. The Corporate Transparency Act is intended to provide law enforcement with BOI for the purpose of detecting, preventing and punishing terrorism, money laundering and other misconduct transacted through business entities.

What is my deadline to file a report?

If your business is a "reporting company", the report mus be filed with FinCEN by January 1, 2025. If you fail to report a qualifying business, The Corporate Transparency Act includes penalties for non-compliance.

The Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) Office of Minority Economic Empowerment (OMEE) is excited to announce the launch of the State Small Business Credit Initiative (SSBCI) Technical Assistance (TA) Loan TA Program. We are seeking proposals from qualified technical assistance providers to support businesses owned by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals (SEDI) and very small businesses (VSBs) participating in or seeking assistance from SSBCI-funded programs.

This initiative aims to provide statewide support to eligible beneficiaries of the SSBCI Technical Assistance (TA) Grant Program. The Loan TA Program will assist small businesses in applying for SSBCI funding and other government small business programs. We prioritize services that promote equitable economic opportunities by enhancing businesses' awareness, readiness, and capability to acquire capital, foster entrepreneurial growth, and improve financial and business management skills.

Eligible Applicants include:

- Legal, Accounting, or Financial advisory Non-Profit or For-Profit entities.
- Collaborative application submissions from eligible entities may include business support organizations, economic development organizations, for-profit or non-profit professional entities, or community development financial institutions. Applicants are strongly encouraged to partner with other federally funded technical assistance providers, such as the Illinois Small Business Development Centers, funded in part by the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA), for the provision of a portion of resources to maximize the efficiency and effectiveness of services provided.

Potential applicants must be able to administer the three (3) TA services – legal, accounting, and financial advisory services, and any wraparound services – to eligible beneficiaries, either directly or through a coalition of contractual partners.

Award Information

- DCEO intends to award six (6) grants eligible applicants within defined geographic regions across the state.
- \bullet Each award is intended for one of the six specified service regions detailed on pages 4 5 of the NOFO.

Applicants may apply for multiple service regions but must submit separate applications for each. Total amount of funding expected to be awarded through this NOFO is \$4,200,000. Awards will range up to \$700,000.
